Justice is Blind and Unfair

Families finding they are facing an accusation do not understand how to approach the system. They say that common sense and justice to be inherent within the system. It really doesn't exist. Rather the justice system is more concerned with power, statistics and numbers and very few attorneys that specialize in fighting false allegations.

Many parents find themselves overwhelmed when dealing with child protective services from investigators and case workers. They are able to manipulate the parents through intimidation and making parents feeling helpless. This type of behavior has to stop if we are to believe in equal justice under the law.

It also my belief their should be a commission to improve the indigent defense in most states. Reexamining the way defendants become eligible for indigent defense and mandates the collection of statistics on race and income levels of the defendants.

Ability to Teach and Learn about Legal Issues

The law touches almost every aspect of modern life. In order to function effectively in modern society each citizen needs to basic understanding of his or her rights and responsibilities before the law. The constitution provides and outline of the rights guaranteed to every citizen. The common law records legal decisions that serve as precedents to be followed in every case of the same general nature. From this foundation the law is constantly changing growing to meet the needs of an expanding society.

Laws maybe changed in two ways: by statute or by court decision. A legislature may pass new laws called statutes to deal with modern problems or where statutes or legal precedents do not offer clear guidelines the court makes its decision by interpreting the earlier law to fit a situation. The courts in one state are not bound by the decision of a court in another state. Of course law decisions may be set aside by statute or modified when it no longer applies to present conditions. Knowing that these laws are there shouldn't we now hold our system to a higher standard and if they choose to contradict one law for another then the court system should be held accountable for their actions or lack of actions.

We are tell us to love and teach our children as well as raise them to be positive individuals in our society. But when a parent may have problems with their children, it's the parents fault and we are doing nothing. Sometimes we as parents don't have all the answers, so what do we do for those that we love and sometimes we make decisions we truly regret. I know first hand because trusting the system cost me my child.

4. To make sure the arrangement of material on the site you are reading the information is user friendly.
5. Remember that the internet **cannot be your only source or a substitution** for medical or other clinical source of information.
6. Be cautious about sharing private information over the internet; you can't be sure that information you divulge will remain private.
7. Use search engines and key words to help you find the information you need.
